PUBLIC NOTICE

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Please be advised that the City Commission of the City of Sanford will be conducting a meeting on Monday, August 16, 2010, commencing at 2:00 p.m., or as soon as proximate to that time as feasible, in the Railroad Depot Room at City Hall, 300 North Park Avenue, Sanford, Florida, and at other location as set forth in this Notice. The purpose of the meeting at City Hall is to meet with Congresswoman Corrine Brown and Congressman John Mica in order to discuss matters related to the Sanford Housing Authority as well as associated subjects and matters.

At approximately 4:00 p.m. Congressman Mica and the City Commission will travel to the Auto Train station located in Sanford at 600 South Persimmon Avenue and meet in the Master Mechanical Building (located on the immediate left after going over the tracks) to discuss Persimmon Avenue as well as associated subjects and matters. It is anticipated that this meeting will conclude by 6:00 p.m.

Although no action is anticipated to be taken at the subject meeting, all persons are hereby advised that, pursuant to Section 286.0105, *Florida Statutes*, any person desiring to appeal any decision made by the City Commission, with respect to any matter considered at any meeting or hearing, will need a record of the proceedings and may need to ensure that a verbatim record of the proceedings is made which includes the testimony and evidence upon which the appeal is to be based. This record is not provided by the City of Sanford.
