These items are OK to Donate:

Appliances
Computers with hard drives scrubbed
Electronics
Bicycles
Sporting Goods
Tools of all kinds
Yard and Garden Equipment
Lawn Mowers and Outdoor Equipment
Furniture
Clothes/Shoes
Plants- Potted/Trees etc.
Kitchen Utensils



Guidelines:

No hazardous waste
Do not include unlawful items or weapons of any kind
Do not put out junk, use your best judgment
Do not include food items
Items should include durable goods, furniture, sporting goods
While driving, be alert for vehicles that may be stopping quickly
If you stop to pick up items, turn on your hazard lights
Please respect local ordinances
